<b>Description</b> Firefox' Private Browsing mode uses a separate IndexedDB instance. This would not normally be a problem, except: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Haketilo's popup and settings page access the "private" instance</li><li>• Haketilo's actions on web pages are always decided and performed using the "non-private" instance</li></ul> This leads to inconsistency - someone browsing in Private Mode can <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• change some configuration in the settings page or</li><li>• install/update packages from the popup and then find out that the changes didn't take effect at all.</li></ul> An immediate workaround will probably be displaying a proper message in those cases. A real but also more complex solution will be to route IndexedDB operations through the background script.
